CHASS IT recently worked along with the college's Director of Communication, Lauren Kirkpatrick, to implement the new college website design. This design was created by the university's Communication Services group. The unit has also begun working with various departments to upgrade computers to Windows 7 in order to take advantage of several server-side technologies such as SCCM. Additionally, two members of CHASS IT, Alan Gerber and Chris Smith, spent significant time re-architecting the campus Velocity service (<http://velocity.ncsu.edu>). This is a campus-wide project that allows for easy transfer of large files that can not be sent through email due to file size limitations. The system began out of Alan's work in CNR and is a joint project between CNR, CHASS, the College of Engineering, and OIT. Also, as a reminder, many of the technology-equipped classrooms maintained by CHASS IT in Winston, Caldwell, and Tompkins are equipped with MediaSite recording systems allowing faculty the option to record their lectures or presentations.
