This change in status may negatively affect a student in several ways, depending on their circumstances. Several possibilities whereby students may be affected include:

- Progress toward degree and anticipated graduation date,
- Student financial aid and future eligibility,
- Eligibility for on-campus housing,
- Health insurance and other insurance coverage,
- NCSU Parking,
- Eligibility for participation on inter-collegiate athletic teams,
- Free tickets for University athletic and other events
- Distribution of present and future scholarships.
